Results

- 2013: I ran one race in the AWRCS series in the QXC Utility class and ended 2nd in my class and 24th overall out of 80 racers.
- 2014: I ran one race in the AWRCS series in the QXC Utility class and ended 1st in my class and 27th overall out of 120 racers.
- 2015: I ran all 10 races of the AWRCS series in the QXC Utility class and ended 1st in my class for the year. There were 18 total racers in my class and I had multiple wins and top 3 finishes. I also ran the Powerline Park GNCC in the 4x4 A/B class and finished 5th in my class and 55th overall out of 294 racers.
- 2016: I ran the entire AWRCS series all except for one round and came in a very close 2nd place in the QXC Utility class. There were 19 total racers in my class. I finished the year with multiple wins and top 3 finishes. I also ran 6 out of the 13 rounds in the GNCC series and ended up taking 7th place in the 4x4 A/B class out of 32 total racers in the class. I finished the year with 2 class wins out of the 6 rounds I was able to attend.
- 2017: I am curently running every round of the GNCC series in the 4x4A class. I ended up placing 2nd in the class this season in a very close points race. I have had an absolutely amazing season with multiple class wins, multiple top 10 overall finishes, and two top amateur overall awards. I have also ran 5 races in the AWRCS series this season, securing multiple class wins.
